CRI – SimuCase – A New Interactive Clinical Decision Learning Tool

This 90-minute session will take participants through two SimuCase scenarios, which are designed to help members of interdisciplinary teams prepare for a range of critical care situations.

The SimuCases are supported by a sophisticated learning technology that allows learners to interact through the facilitator with a virtual situation and patient. This technology simulates the real-life course of acutely ill patients in critical care settings and allows students to experience the results of decisions made and actions taken as they progress through the scenario.

High Fidelity Simulation Course – Massive Bleeding

Get first-hand experience with the power of High Fidelity Simulation (HFS) as a learning tool while also strengthening your crisis resource management skills.

This 90-minute session will introduce our HFS course in massive bleeding. It will allow hands-on interaction for a participant team and give audience members an opportunity to see the high-fidelity simulation process and debriefing session in action.

An HFS session consists of an observed real-time encounter with a simulated patient in the presence of a nurse and respiratory therapist, and with the assistance of other physicians if necessary. Theatre-based HFS sessions are videotaped for detailed feedback and instruction. HFS effectively simulates (psychologically) a real patient encounter, which permits “safe” practice of the crisis resource management approach to emergent situations. HFS is an integral component of CRI educational offerings.
